Welcome

The Grand Harbour will once again provide the perfect setting for this event. The festival is being held as part of 7th anniversary celebrations of Malta's accession into the European Union (2004).

Participating in the festival are numerous Maltese firework factories and three foreign firework companies: Parente Fireworks Group, Italy; Pyrovision Ltd, Austria and Venefuego Fireworks C.A, Venezuela. A selection of the firework displays will be synchronized to music. Five Maltese firework factories will be competing for the Best Fireworks Display trophy, the public's vote and cash prizes.

Tradition of Fireworks in Malta

Fireworks in Malta have a long tradition which goes back to the time of the Order of the Knights of St John. The *feu de joie*, the *musketterija*, the *solfarelli d'aria*, *irdieden* (St Catherine's wheels) and other forms of fireworks originated from explosives that were lit off from mortars and muskets as an expression of celebration on special occasions, such as the election of a grand master, a pope or the birth of a prince. Firework displays were developed further during the 19th and 20th century to become what they are today. This centuries—old traditional craft may be enjoyed especially during the festive season all over Malta and Gozo.
