
Dear Colleagues!

According to the latest data in the field of explosive materials in Russia there are 1318 supervised organizations, including:

- 1134 organizations associated with the operation of hazardous production facilities (production, storage, use and transportation of explosives);
- 73 organizations for training and qualification of blasters and other employees for specified hazardous production facilities;
- 31 specialized design organizations;
- 50 expert organizations;
- 30 construction companies (construction, expansion, renovation, modernization of hazardous production facilities).

Amounts of explosives used by organizations in Russia, have increased by 15% and amounted to 1 171.414 tonnes per year.

THE CONFERENCE

The EFEE World Conference has established itself as one of the key explosives forums both in Europe and Internationally. Our previous conferences that we held in past years attracted over 500 delegates from over 50 different countries.

The conference includes technical sessions, an exhibition, educational workshops, welcome drinks reception, gala dinner and partner programme. The abstract should be a written summary of work done on the project, what conclusions have been drawn up and recommendations made as a result of the project. The proposed paper should not be of a commercial or advertising nature. Please complete our online submission form to express an interest in submitting an abstract. Author's paper formatting and presentation guidelines will be sent to authors along with their notification of abstract acceptance.
